Jupiter	~12 years	Growth, expansion, and meaning. Marks opportunities for learning, travel, and purpose.	12, 24, 36, 48, 60, 72...
Saturn	~29.5 years	Structure, responsibility, and mastery. Saturn returns and squares mark maturity checkpoints.	7 (square) 14 (opposition) 21 (square) 29–30 (return) 59–60 (2nd return)
Uranus	~84 years	Liberation, breakthrough, and individuality. Major aspects signal identity shifts and reinvention.	21 (square) 42 (opposition) 63 (square) 84 (return)
Neptune	~165 years	Vision, dissolution, and spiritual evolution. Transits are subtle but transformative.	28–29 (sextile) 40–42 (square) 55–57 (trine) 82–84 (opposition)

The Key Life Stages

Experience your personal evolution through the rhythms of Jupiter, Saturn, Uranus, Neptune & Chiron

Age 6–7

Saturn opening square (90°)

Theme: Learning limits and roles. Developing discipline, school routines, and early responsibility.

Body: Post-babyhood growth stabilizes; greater physical coordination and independence.

Age 11–12

Jupiter return

Theme: New horizons. Curiosity peaks, expansion through learning, ideals, and exploration.

Body: Start of puberty; hormonal changes may spark self-consciousness or restlessness.

Age 13–14

Saturn opposition (180°)

Theme: Internal vs. external authority. Testing boundaries, navigating adolescence and identity crisis.

Body: Teen growth spurts, changing body image, need for rest and resilience.

Age 20–21

Saturn closing square (270°)

Theme: Early adulthood wake-up call. Time to assess goals, finances, and life path. Coincides with opening Uranus square and adds themes of individuation and independence.

Body: Brain matures fully; energy may fluctuate with stress or emerging health patterns.

Age 23–24

Second Jupiter return

Theme: Confidence boost. New opportunities in career, travel, or spirituality. Vision for the future expands.

Body: Physical energy often high—peak period for exploration and pushing limits.

Age 27–29

Neptune sextile (60°)

Theme: Overlaps with Saturn return. Subtle inspiration. A quiet opening to dreams, creativity, or spiritual curiosity. Often seeds long-term vision or intuitive gifts.

Body: Heightened sensitivity to mood, sound, and substance. Restorative practices like meditation or music can deeply nourish.

Age 27–30

Saturn return

Theme: Adult initiation. Shedding illusions, choosing lasting commitments. Establishment in society (marriage, build/buy home, become a parent, build career/business)

Body: Aging awareness begins. May feel heavier, tired, or more in tune with long-term wellness needs.

Age 35–38

Saturn opening square (90°, 2nd time)

Theme: Pressure to mature further. Challenges arise to test the foundations laid during the Saturn return. Reassessment of roles, parenting, and professional identity.

Body: Subtle signs of aging surface—fatigue, muscle tension, or hormonal fluctuations. Body signals the need for sustainable rhythms and recovery.

Age 40–42

Neptune square (90°)

Theme: A period of soul-searching and emotional fog. Spiritual questioning and reevaluation of ideals. Often coincides with the Uranus opposition, creating a potent midlife “crisis” or awakening.

Body: Fatigue, sleep disruption, and immune sensitivity may reflect blurred boundaries and a need for gentler rhythms.

Age 42-44

Uranus opposition (180°)

Theme: Midlife crisis. Questioning everything—career, marriage, locality, identity. Desire for freedom and authenticity.

Body: Energy may spike or crash. Sleep changes, libido shifts, and the urge for reinvention arise.

Age 47–49

Saturn opposition (180°, 2nd time)

Theme: Life audit. Balancing past accomplishments with emotional truths. Re-centering around authenticity.

Body: Health check-in—bones, joints, skin, knees. Call to realign lifestyle with deeper values.

Age 49–51

Chiron return

Theme: Deep healing. Revisiting old wounds to reclaim wisdom and purpose. Mentor role may emerge. Often follows on the wake of the Saturn opposition.

Body: Menopause/andropause shifts. Pain from unresolved emotional or physical trauma may surface for healing.

Age 52–54

Saturn closing square (270°, 2nd time)

Theme: Restructure and release. A pressure point for evaluating what’s sustainable—roles, commitments, or habits. Let go of what drains your energy and reinforce what grounds you.

Body: Tension in bones, spine, or teeth may reflect internal pressure to restructure. Requires sustainable routines and mindful self-discipline.

Age 55–57

Neptune trine (120°)

Theme: A graceful opening to inner peace, artistic flow, or spiritual refinement. Idealism may mature into compassion or creative wisdom. Often overlaps with Chiron return or post-Saturn return integration.

Body: Increased sensitivity to toxins, enhanced receptivity to water-based or subtle healing methods.

Age 59–60

Second Saturn return

Theme: Culmination and consolidation. It brings the harvest of the past 29 years. Letting go happens here too, but with a sense of integration and refinement—distilling life experience into wisdom, deciding what's worth carrying forward into the next chapter.

Body: Slower metabolism, bone density awareness. Re-committing to holistic self-care.

Age 63

Uranus closing square (270°)

Theme: Radical freedom. Liberation from past identities, and societal and familial roles. A call to prioritize joy, curiosity, and independent thinking.

Body: Nervous system sensitivity may increase. Mental and creative stimulation become vital for vitality and joy.

Age 82–84

Neptune opposition (180°)

Theme: A culmination or release of lifelong dreams, ideals, and illusions. For some, this is a deeply spiritual time; for others, it may mark disorientation or surrender. It's often an invitation to dissolve the ego and embrace the eternal. This phase overlaps with the Uranus return.

Body: Disorientation or fluid imbalance may signal a softening of physical focus; rest and gentleness are essential.

Age 83–84

Uranus return

Theme: Soul freedom. Living authentically with detachment and lightness. Legacy shines through being, not doing.

Body: Frailty may increase, but spiritual or mental clarity often heightens. Emphasis on presence, peace, and essence.

Pluto

Because **Pluto's orbit is highly elliptical**, **Pluto transits vary dramatically** depending on your **natal Pluto's sign and degree**. Pluto spends **anywhere from 12 to 30 years** in a sign and **moves fastest** through **Scorpio** and **slowest** through **Taurus**.

General Manifestation of Pluto's Cycles

Pluto sextile Pluto (60°)

Theme: Empowerment through integration. Opportunity to claim personal authority and spiritual depth without force.

Body: Awareness of cellular aging. Focus shifts to resilience and longevity. Healing becomes more holistic and soul-centered.

Pluto opening/waxing square (90°)

Theme: Inner upheaval and regeneration. A deep psychological reckoning. Subconscious patterns surface for transformation.

Body: Intense energy fluctuations. Possible burnout or renewal through crisis. Detoxification—physically and emotionally—may become necessary.

Pluto trine Pluto (120°)

Theme: Wisdom through surrender. Quiet strength, ability to influence through presence and legacy. Letting go becomes regenerative.

Body: The physical body slows, but subtle energies strengthen. Transformation is inward, often peaceful, and attuned to ancestral rhythms.

Pluto opposition Pluto (180°)

Theme: Reckoning and renewal. A culminating encounter with one's life story, shadow, and soul legacy. Invitations to integrate the deepest truths and prepare for spiritual transition.

Body: Vital force wanes; physical vulnerability increases. Yet, there may be flashes of inner clarity, psychic sensitivity, or profound peace. The body becomes a vessel for closure and soul release.
